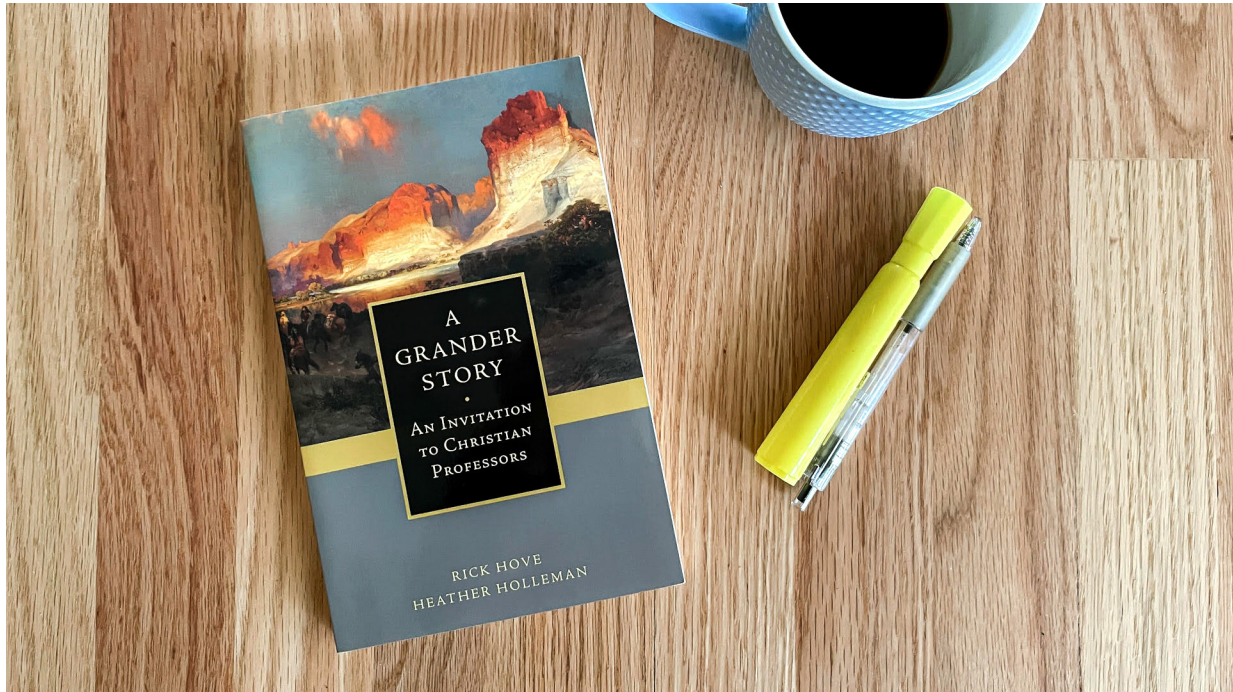


# How To Lead "A Grander Story"

## Bible Study



This book study is a great resource to challenge and encourage faculty in living for Christ in academia. The first half of the book grounds people in their identity in Christ. The second half gives real life examples of professors that God is using to successfully minister to students and colleagues.

### **I. Pray**

Ask God to work in the study of this book.

### **II. Gather**

Bring together a group of fellow Christian faculty on your campus to work through the book together. Order the books you need from Amazon or Christian Book Distributors.

### **III. Meet**

Meet together weekly. Cover one chapter per week. You will find discussion questions at the end of each chapter. The facilitator will want to use the questions as a resource to design your own discussions. Don't feel like you have to use every question the book suggests. Don't hurry through the material. Seek to make proper application at the end of each chapter. Close each study with prayer for one another. Don't rush through the material without caring for one another.

### **IV. Apply**

As you work through the ministry examples of the professors featured in the book, try to come up with ideas that you could implement on your campus. Don't be overwhelmed. Some of the faculty have been doing ministry for years to develop what they are doing. Try to be realistic and take what you can do and come up with a plan that is suitable for you and your campus.
